## ROWING SUMMER SCHOOL 2023

**Starts Monday 24th July ends Friday 18th August**

4 weekly courses for juniors who wish to learn to row, recommended age range 12 to 16.

Each course will cover the basics of rowing and equipment and will include time on the water.

Up to 3 weeks may be booked. More than one week allows greater skill and confidence to develop.

Completing a course qualifies juniors to apply to join the September intake of new Royal Chester Rowing Club junior members. The junior squad size is limited so membership may not be automatic.
