Beginning Monday 25th July, 9-00 till 12 noon. Mon 1st August, Mon 8th August, Mon 15th August. Royal Chester Rowing Club continues to deliver our ever popular Summer School, as part of British Rowing's Go Rowing programme and the club's Junior Rowing programme. We reserve the right to cancel and offer alternative dates if a week has little interest and attendance is low.

WE AIM:

- To introduce rowing to pupils finishing years 7 to 10 (12 to 17 years) at schools (not offering rowing) in the Chester area, including those linked to the club.
- To find pupils not yet involved in sport, particularly those from a disadvantaged background.
- 'Open door' rowing for all in a safe and coached environment all year round.

Capacity is limited and the maximum enrolment per session will be 20. Attending one week or up to three weeks is up to the individual as we understand holidays will encroach. Grants are available upon request to those needing financial support. Courses may be cancelled and refunded if coronavirus restrictions are imposed or if a minimum of 6 are not booked.

In September there will be the opportunity to apply to become a member of Royal Chester Rowing Club if you wish to continue rowing, however attendance at Summer School does not automatically result in membership.

- Learn to scull, row, cox and steer.
- Learn to use a rowing machine.
- Progress your rowing from singles to doubles, then to crew boats.
- COST: £175 PER WEEK.
- **SESSIONS:** Mondays to Fridays 9.00am - 12 noon, starting on 25th July, finishing week begins 15th August.
